

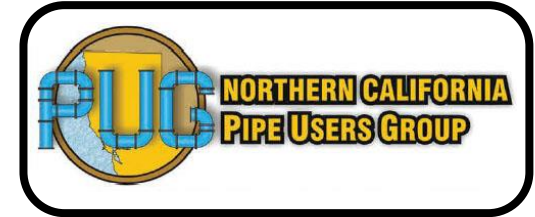
Call For Papers

The **Pipe Users Group** is a forum of collection and water system owners, engineers, contractors, vendors and suppliers dedicated to:

- Evaluating new and current rehab and installation methods;
- Improving the design, construction, and operation of sewer and water systems;
- Pooling of resources for demonstrations, workshops, field trips and seminars showcasing new and existing technologies; and
